



February Meet Planning Underway

Yes, there will be a 1990 President's Day R/C Scale Model Boat Meet in beautiful Tempe, Arizona. The date is Feb 17-18, 1990 and the site will once again be the fantastic Kiwanis Park Lake.

This year's events will be expanded to include a night run on Saturday night followed by the actual meet on Sunday.

A major change for the meet will be the fact that it will also be known as the Scale Ship Modelers of North America (SSMA) Region 10 Regionals. Region 10 covers the 4-corner states of Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico and Utah but competition is open to anyone.

The 1990 Meet will

once again be managed by members of the Mesa Model Yacht Club which has already begun planning for February. Meet Coordinator Ray Agee has started gathering judges and getting various government agencies involved.

As in 1989, Arizona's Governor Rose Mofford is expected to declare February 1990 as Radio Controlled Model Boating Month. City of Tempe Mayor Harry Mitchell is also expected to declare a special observance for the Meet honoring our hobby-sport as he did in 1989.

Governor Mofford's Proclamation is believed to be the first such recognition by a state governor in the U.S.

In addition to competition in Military, Working,

Pleasure, Steam, Sail, Static, Submarine and Junior Divisions, special awards will be given including Most Unusual and Best Historical Presentation.

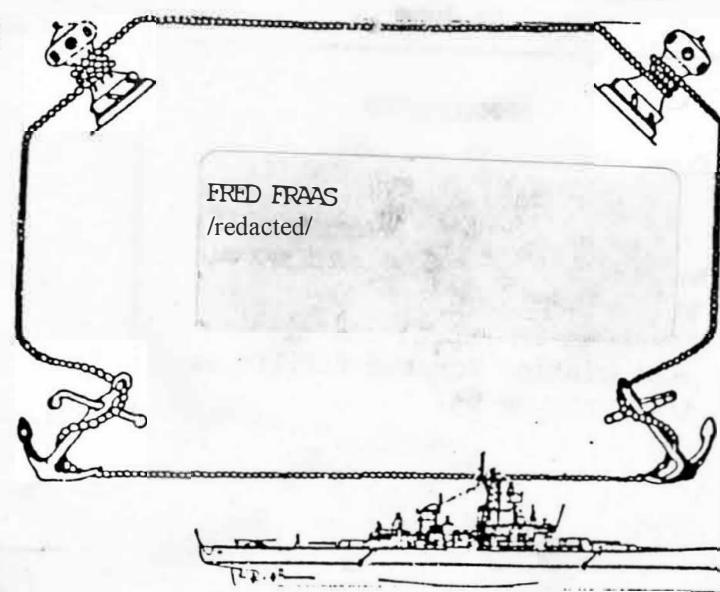

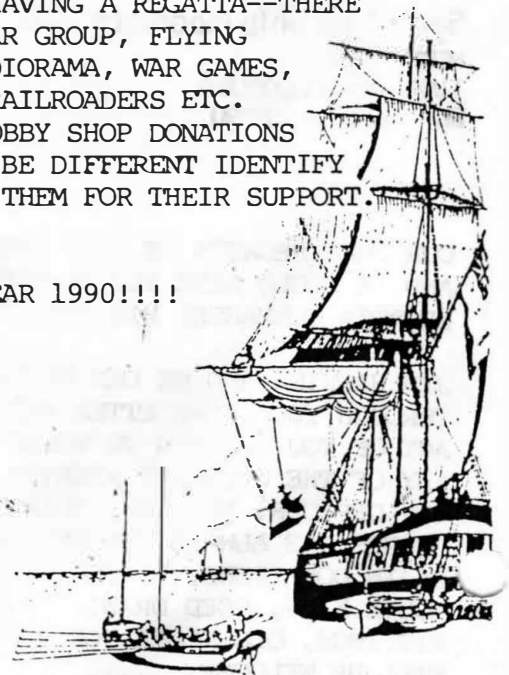

MEMBER ID NBR: Leave blank, a number will be assigned at time of initial data entry. This number will be used as a key to entering and retrieving data for each member of the guild. Your member id number will appear on a master roster, and you will use this number to add, modify, or delete information from the database.

{nn} This symbol indicates the maximum number of characters that can be used to provide the requested information. ie: HULL NUMBER {15} indicates that you have 15 characters of information that you may use for a ships hull number.

Fill out the name and address portion of the form, business phone is optional.

=> BE SURE TO INCLUDE YOUR R/C FREQUENCY, a list will be generated with this information.
=> IF YOU USE MORE THAN ONE FREQUENCY, PLEASE INDICATE THOSE ALSO IN ADDITIONAL SPACES.

PLEASE include PAST models you have done as well as CURRENT completions and WORK IN PROCESS.

Under the headings Category, Power, Method, and Hull insert the appropriate 2 digit numerical code.

I have left gaps so that additional breakdowns can be inserted.

Please include scale, I will fit it in and make it useful somehow.

Be sure to include special talents and skills at the bottom of the form.

On the reverse side there is a plans section and a books section to fill out also.
