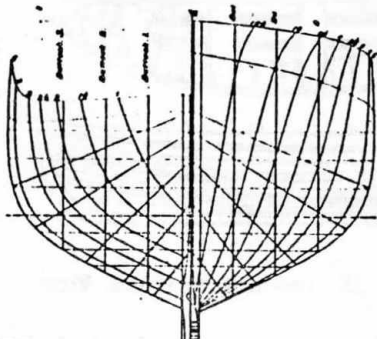
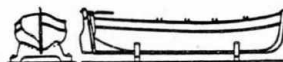
THERE WERE USUALLY VARIOUS KINDS OF BOATS ON BOARD SHIPS, AND THEY WERE NAMED ACCORDING TO THE USE THEY WERE BUILT FOR. THUS THERE WAS THE LAUNCH, i.e. THE LARGEST BOAT EMPLOYED BY WAR VESSELS, OFTEN EQUIPPED WITH A SAIL; THE BUNDLE SHALLOP, i.e. A BOAT DISASSEMBLED IN VARIOUS PIECES KEPT ON BOARD THE SHIP. IT WAS ASSEMBLED ONLY IF NEEDED. THE CUTTER, THE ONE PERMANENTLY FASTENED ON BOARD THE SHIP, WHICH, WHEN UNDER SAIL, WAS TOWED; THE ARMED CUTTER, THE ONE USED FOR SPECIAL MISSIONS AND WHICH CARRIED IN ADDITION TO THE CREW, THE ARMED MEN NECESSARY FOR THE VENTURE.



THE NAME LOOK-OUT BOAT WAS GIVEN TO THE BOAT USED FOR EXPLORATION, WHILE THE LAUNCH (OR ANCHOR HOY) WAS THE LARGEST AND STRONGEST BOAT, EQUIPPED FOR WORK AT SEA, AS FOR EXAMPLE, LAYING OUT AN ANCHOR.



THE ROW-BOAT WAS THE SMALLEST BOAT ON BOARD, AND WAS USED FOR ALL PURPOSES NOT REQUIRING A LAUNCH. THE LAUNCH WAS AND STILL IS THE TYPICAL BOAT EMPLOYING OARS USED BY ALL SHIPS IN THE PAST AND IN THE PRESENT, FOR VARIOUS SERVICE. IT USUALLY WAS EQUIPPED WITH A SAIL.

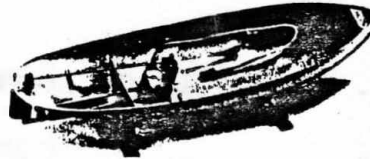

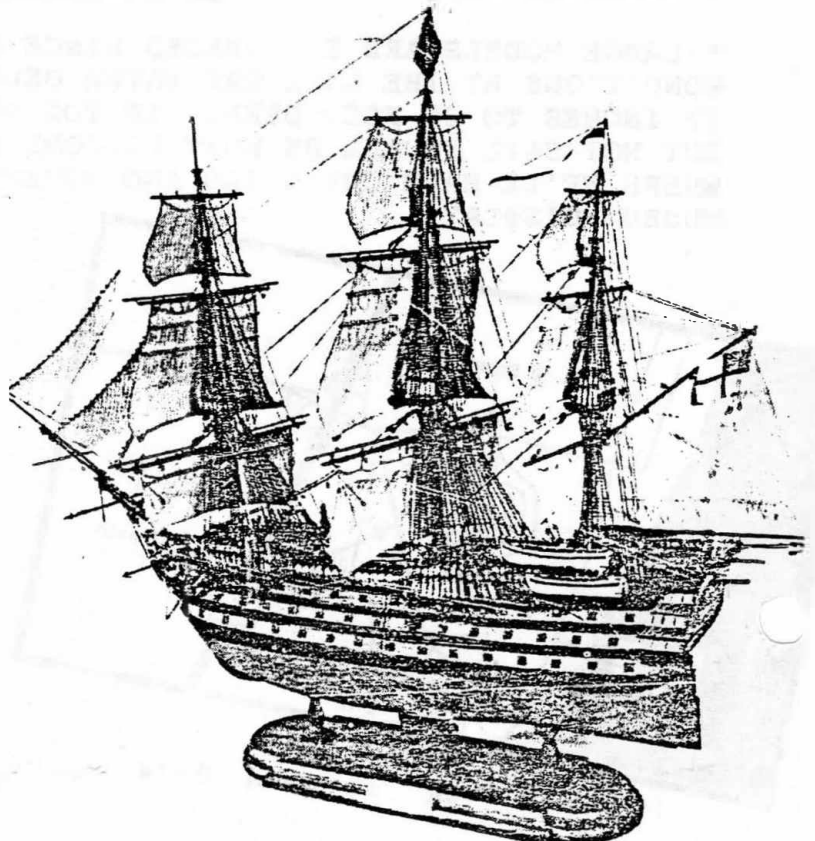

San Diego Ship Modelers' Guild

The San Diego Ship Modelers Guild announces their 14th Annual Scale Model R/C Regatta to be held Saturday, June 15 & 16, 1991 at the Model Yacht Basin in San Diego's Mission Bay Park. The contest will be open to all types of scale ships and boats using steam, electric or sail power (sorry, hydroplanes not included).

The competition will consist of three portions: Operational, Static and Dioramas. In the Operational portion, models will be judged on their scale appearance and their operation at which time they will have to navigate an obstacle course and demonstrate their scale operational capability including special effects. In the Static portion models will be judged only on their scale appearance. In the Diorama portion models will be judged on their appearance and subject matter (nautical theme). Operational categories will be sail, steam, electric, military and civilian, submarine, tug, and salvage/ workboat.

Trophies will be awarded to the First Place winner in each category, with ribbons for Second and Third Place winners. Additional trophies will be awarded to the Best of Show, Best Junior Modeler (for modelers under 18 years of age), Spectators Favorite and Modelers Favorite.

Entry Fee will be \$5.00 per model for Operational and \$4.00 per model for Static and Diorama. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. We ask that you preregister by mail, especially if you plan to enter a Steam or a model 14" and under, you will be the first on the pond.

A Potluck Dinner will follow the Regatta around 5:30 p.m. with The Guild supplying the barbecue grill and briquettes. Yes, we will have a grill this year.

As in Regattas before we have been invited by the Management of The Vacation Village Hotel to run our models the evening of the 15th in the Hotel Lagoon.

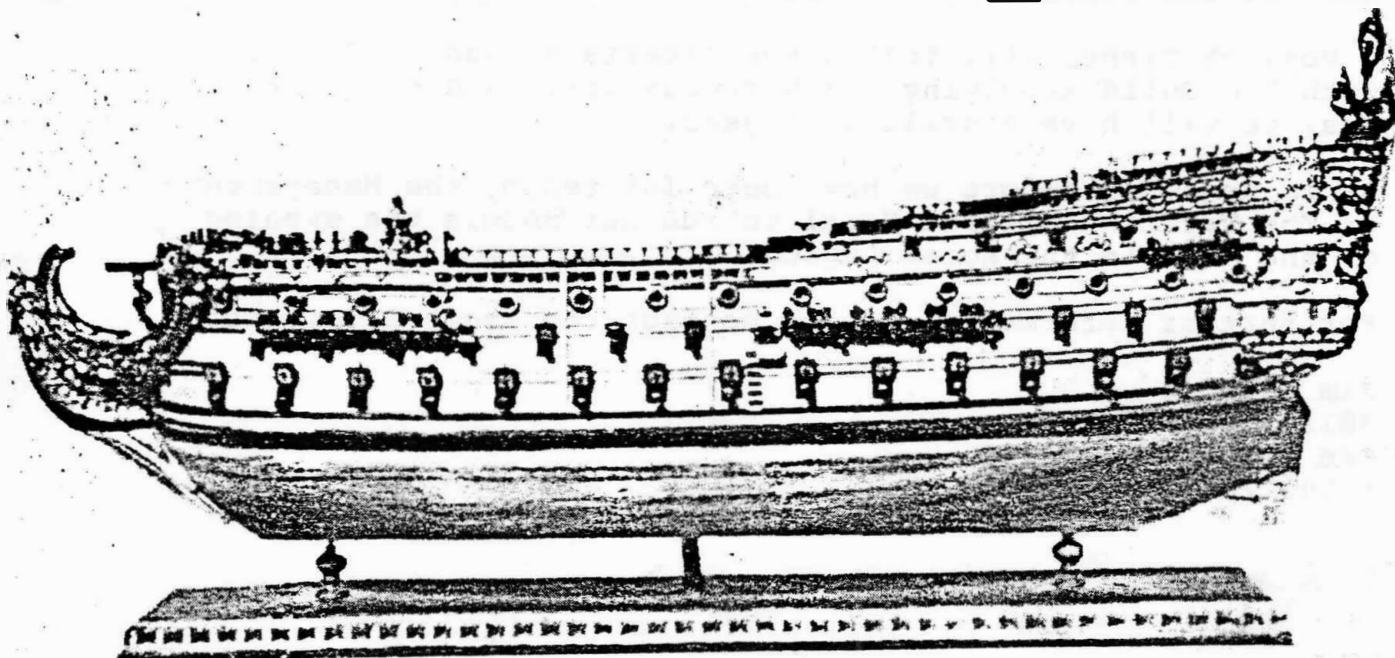

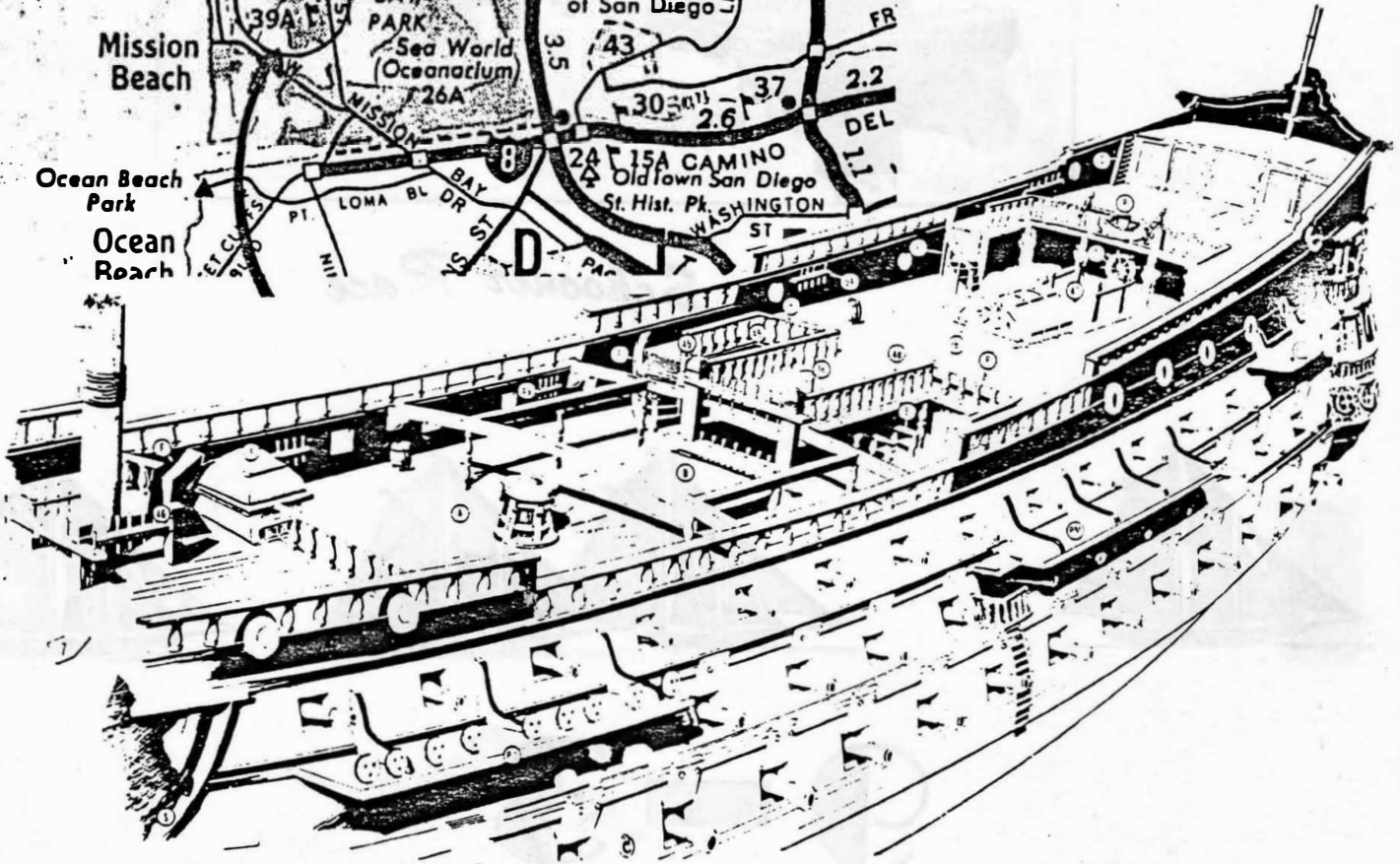
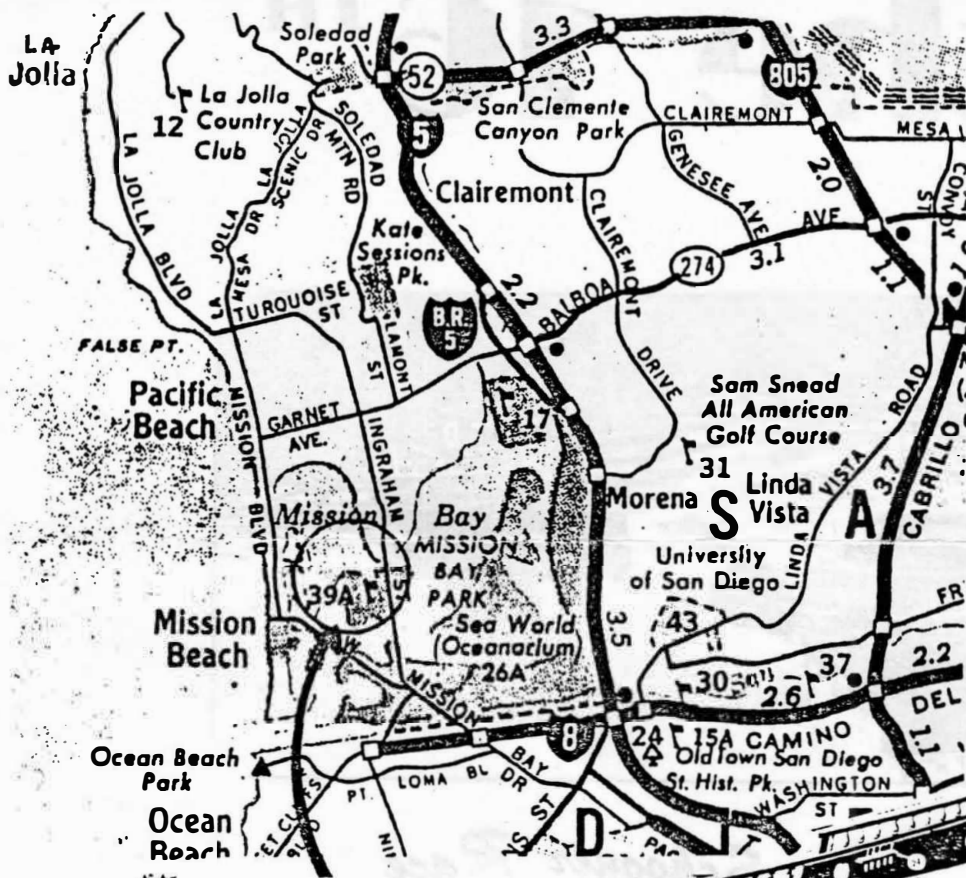

LIGHTS, TURN LEFT ON PACIFIC PRINCESS HOTEL. YOU'RE HERE...

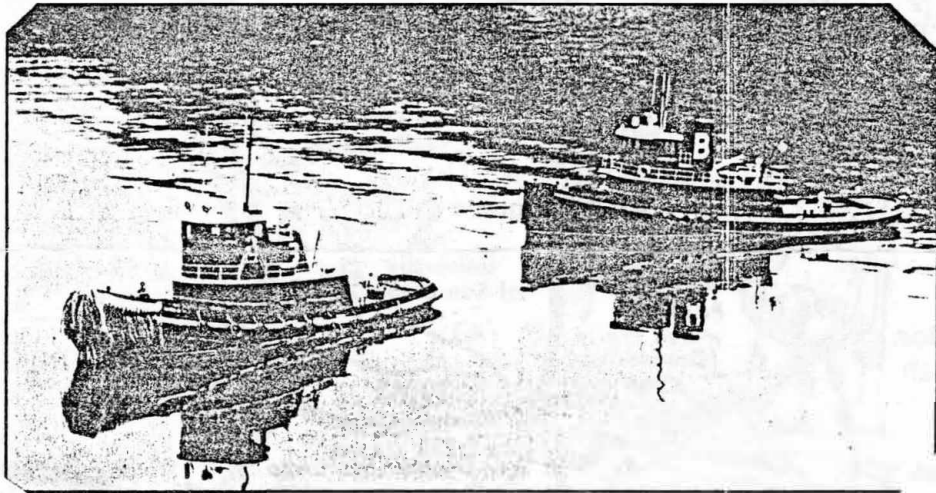
FROM HWY 5 SOUTH EXIT ON HWY 8 EAST , EXIT TAYLOR ST GO

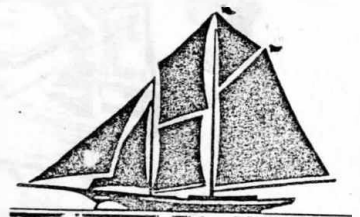
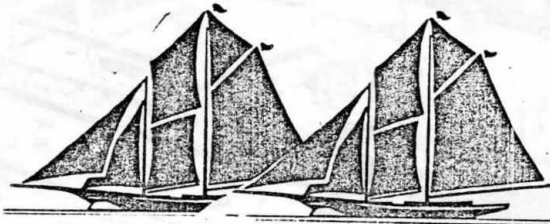
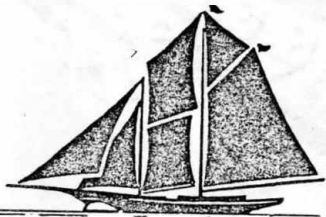
— Perspective view of the hull of the San Felipe, a Spanish ship-of-the line of 1693.
