LAKE MEAD BOULDER BASIN



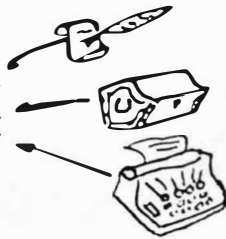
